

JAWAHARLAL NEHRU TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY HYDERABAD **GOLDEN JUBILEE CELEBRATIONS**





November 13, 2021: Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Hyderabad (JNTUH) - Golden Jubilee Celebrations and JNTUH Alumni Association - First Annual Convention in the USA.

History and Background:

The Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University (JNTU) was established in Hyderabad on 2nd October 1972 as the first-ever Technological University in INDIA. After 37 years of relentless service to the society at large, JNTU was restructured into four different universities namely JNTU Hyderabad (JNTUH), JNTU Anantapur (JNTUA), JNTU Kakinada (JNTUK) and Jawaharlal Nehru Fine Arts University by the Government of Andhra Pradesh on September 24, 2008.

JNTUH has a total of 8 constituent colleges and academic institutions: four constituent engineering colleges and four academic units/schools in addition to other administrative functional units.

In addition to the above 8 institutions, there are close to 270 colleges affiliated to JNTUH in the State of Telangana. Close to 2Million students graduated with JNTU Degrees so far. A significant number of them are well settled overseas holding prominent positions. So far, there are no formal JNTUH Alumni Associations established overseas including in the USA.

Formation of JNTUH Alumni Association (USA):

During the COVID-19 in 2020, a core team of JNTUH Alumni from USA under the chairmanship of Dr. Hari Eppanapally took the initiative to establish JNTUH Alumni Association in the USA with clearly defined objectives and goals. Worked closely with the JNTUH Administration to create the constitution, framework and organization structure following the host country (USA) rules and regulations. The four founding members are: Dr. Hari Eppanapally, Swamy Sriperumbudur, Sudhakar Uppala and Praveen Nidumolu.

The first overseas JNTUH Alumni Association was registered in the USA on August 31, 2020, and officially inaugurated on November 15, 2020 by the Chancellor of JNTUH Hon'ble Governor of Telangana Dr. Tamilisai Soundara Rajan and In-charge Vice Chancellor Mr. Jayesh Ranjan, Rector Prof. A, Govardhan, Registrar Prof. Manzur Hussain along with the principals and directors of all the constituent colleges graced the occasion.

TECHNOLOGIC

First Annual Convention:

On November 13, 2021, the JNTUH Alumni Association (USA) organized First Annual Convention in Princeton, New Jersey, USA and celebrated the Golden Jubilee. Several dignitaries from JNTU Hyderabad graced the occasion including the Vice-Chancellor Dr. Katta Narsimha Reddy as chief guest, Dr. A. Govardhan (Rector), Dr. Manzoor Hussain (Registrar), Dr. NC Shivaprakash (Chairman BOG, CEH), and Dr. A Prabhu Kumar (Principal, CEH) as guests of honor along with Dr. G. Vijaya Kumari (Director, JNTUH Innovation HUB). Also, Dr. M. Madhavi Latha (Coordinator, JNTUH Alumni Association), Dr. Bhramara Panitapu (Coordinator, JNTUH, CEH Alumni Association) and Dr. S. Vijay Mohan Rao (President, JNTUH Alumni Association) graced the occasion from India as distinguished guests. Over 50 JNTUH alumni to attended the event in person following the COVID-19 guidelines and hundreds of alumni joined virtually on zoom.

Convention Inaugural Session:

The annual convention inaugural session began at 11am EST [9:30pm IST] with the US National Anthem rendered by Ms. Bhaavitha Nekkalaupudi from North Carolina, followed by the Indian National Anthem rendered by Ms. Aimee Elizabeth George from Kuwait.

The JNTUH Alumni Association President Mr. Swamy Sriperumbudur welcomed the guests and the alumni, and Mr. Krishna Kumar Rani, Executive Vice President & Convener for the first annual convention provided an overview and schedule of the planned activities for the day long program. Mr. Swamy Sriperumbudur as host for the inaugural session introduced the founding Chairman Dr. Hari Eppanapally to deliver the inaugural address.

The JNTUH Alumni Association (USA) chairman Dr. Hari Eppanapally, during his inaugural address shared the objectives and the strategic vision & mission of the organization which is to connect and engage the alumni of all the constituent colleges, academic institutions, and affiliated colleges under JNTUH to support the growth of the institutions and to also promote the JNTUH brand globally. The initial focus will be to establish the operations in the USA and gradually extend to other regions of the world. Also, talked about the future plans and modernization of the education system to provide the employable skills to meet the needs of Industry 4.0 needs.

Dr. Eppanapally proudly introduced and appreciated the contributions of the founding members and the executive team of the JNTUH Alumni Association Lead by, President Mr. Swamy Sriperumbudur, executive vice president & convener Mr. Krishna Kumar Rani, Secretary & Treasurer Sudhakar Uppala, International Vice President Praveen Nidumolu, convention team members: Praveen Guduru (co-convener), Mahender Narala, Nagesh Aita and many more volunteers who made this event possible. - 6. Launched J-VEN [JNTUH Ventures] series on August 21, 2021 on the World Entrepreneurs Day. J-VEN is an initiative of JNTUH Alumni Association (USA) to Empower Innovation by connecting the Entrepreneurs and the Investors/Venture Capitalists for the seed and growth capital.
- 7. Celebration of JNTUH Alumni Association (USA) first annual convention and Golden Jubilee Celebrations on November 13, 2021 in Princeton, New Jersey, USA.

Followed by the inaugural address of the Chairman, Mr. Praveen Nidumolu, International Vice President, invited Honorable Vice-chancellor Dr. Katta Narsimha Reddy to inaugurate the convention and deliver the address as chief guest.

- 8. To organize Annual conferences national and regional level to promote JNTUH Culture and empower the Alumni to accomplish the objectives of the JNTUHAA.
- 9. To recognize distinguished Alumni, administrators, faculty, and students of JNTUH for their accomplishments and services.
- 10. To provide humanitarian support during natural calamities and pandemics.

Mr. Sudhakar Uppala also requested the alumni to support the various initiatives of the association and to donate generously for the construction of the alumni building in Hyderabad.

International vice president Mr. Praveen Nidumolu shared about the monthly webinars with world renowned speakers on diverse topics ranging from innovation, entrepreneurship, management & healthy living, etc. He also shared how these webinars engaged and benefitted the alumni since the inception of the organization.

Mr. Nidumolu announced the plans for the Golden Jubilee celebrations and requested the alumni to take active role in planning monthly events in different parts of USA and requested the alumni to take up few initiatives to benefit the Alumni, faculty and staff and also contribute to the growth of the University including raising funds for the JNTUH Alumni Association Building.

Finally, requested the JNTUH alumni to take active role during the coming months and years to build a world class alumni organization globally.
